In addition, Style installed a flush telescopic panel. This provides a completely flush finish along the wall, with smooth lines and a solid wall appearance.

"The 57dB acoustics mean, when closed, there's privacy between the two rooms and the flush telescopic finish ensures the wall is highly discreet when moved into its stacking position."

The panels are manufactured separately to the frame, which means it has interchangeable panels which are easy to change if one is damaged or scuffed, or the interior design of a room changes later on.
